#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The fees include the provision of textbooks and stationery but not the cost of major travel items such as exchanges, school trips and field study courses. Boundary Oak will endeavour to restrict fee increases, however, when such increases take place they are normally effective from September. Fees are due to be paid before the first day of each term. Boundary Oak reserve the right to charge interest on fees which are overdue. One term's written notice (to be given no later than the first day of that term) must be given before the withdrawal of a child or one term's fees will need to be paid in lieu of notice. Similarly a full term's notice in writing is expected if instrumental music and/or drama tuition is to be discontinued. Additional activities, weekend trips and residential trips and extra exam tuition and individual musical instrument tuition will be charged extra each term.
